Write out your spelling words once as given (left side of paper) and then once in alphabetical order (right)	Write each word forward and then backward.  Ex: spelling - gnilleps	Rewrite your spelling words, writing consonants in blue and vowels in red.	Write your spelling words from the shortest word to the longest word
<i>3 Times Each</i>	<i>Spelling Syllables</i>	<i>Bubble Letter Words</i>	<i>Make Your Own</i>
Write each word 3 times: 1 <sup>st</sup> time printed 2 <sup>nd</sup> time cursive 3 <sup>rd</sup> time in color	Classify the words according to the number of syllables and show the syllable division.
